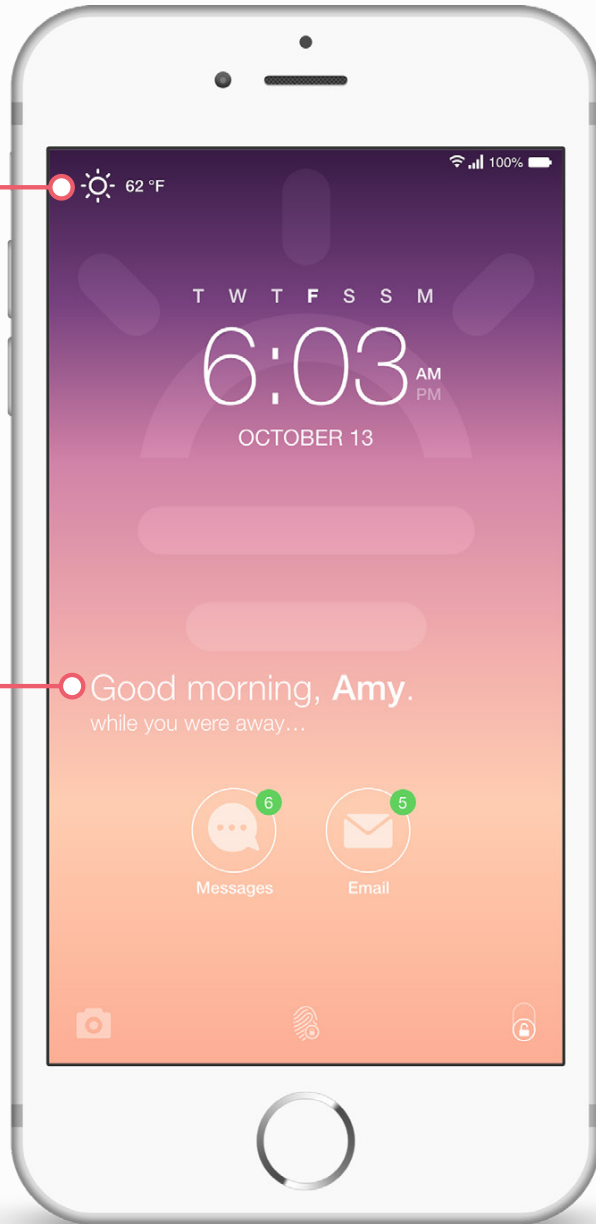

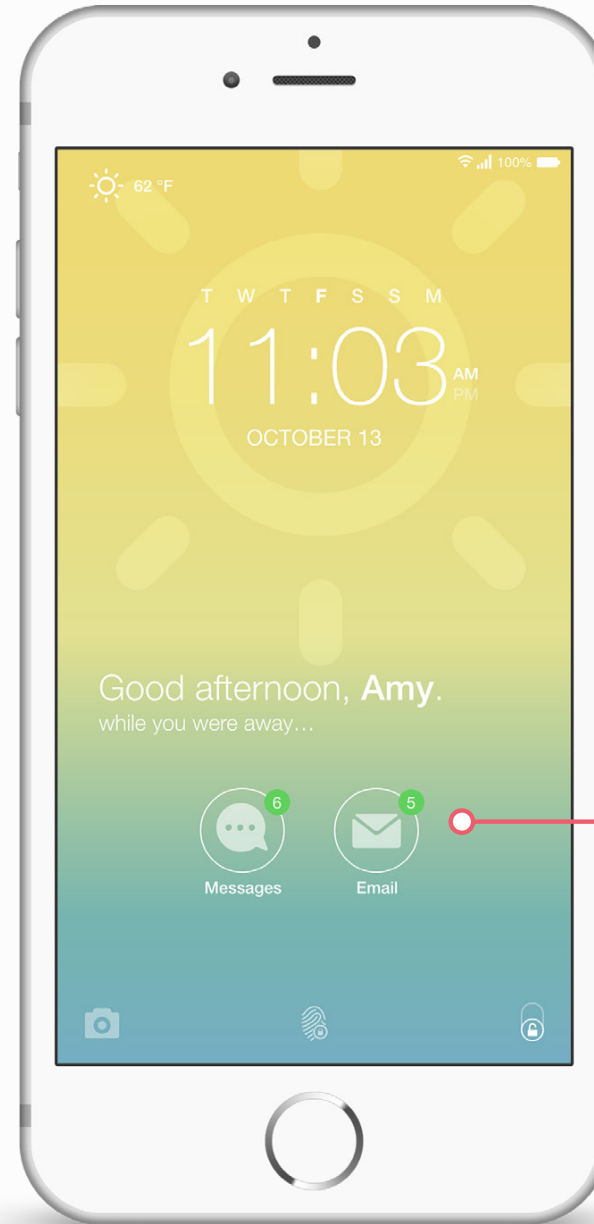
# Lock Screen (Morning & Afternoon)

The current weather is given on the lock screen so users always know what it's like outside.

while you were away...

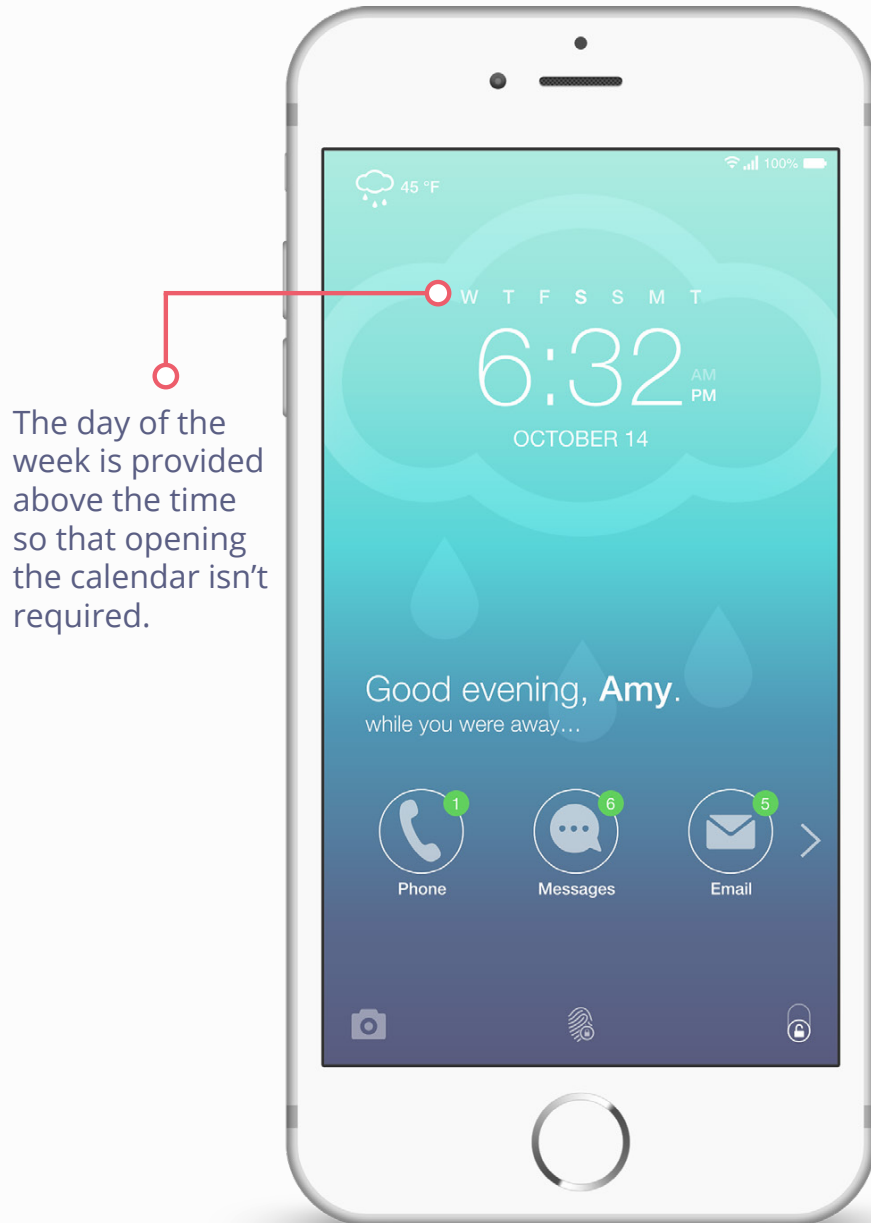
Greets the user based on the time of day (e.g. morning, afternoon, evening, or night).

Important notifications are grouped together at the bottom so users know what they've missed at a glance.

# Lock Screen (Evening & Night)



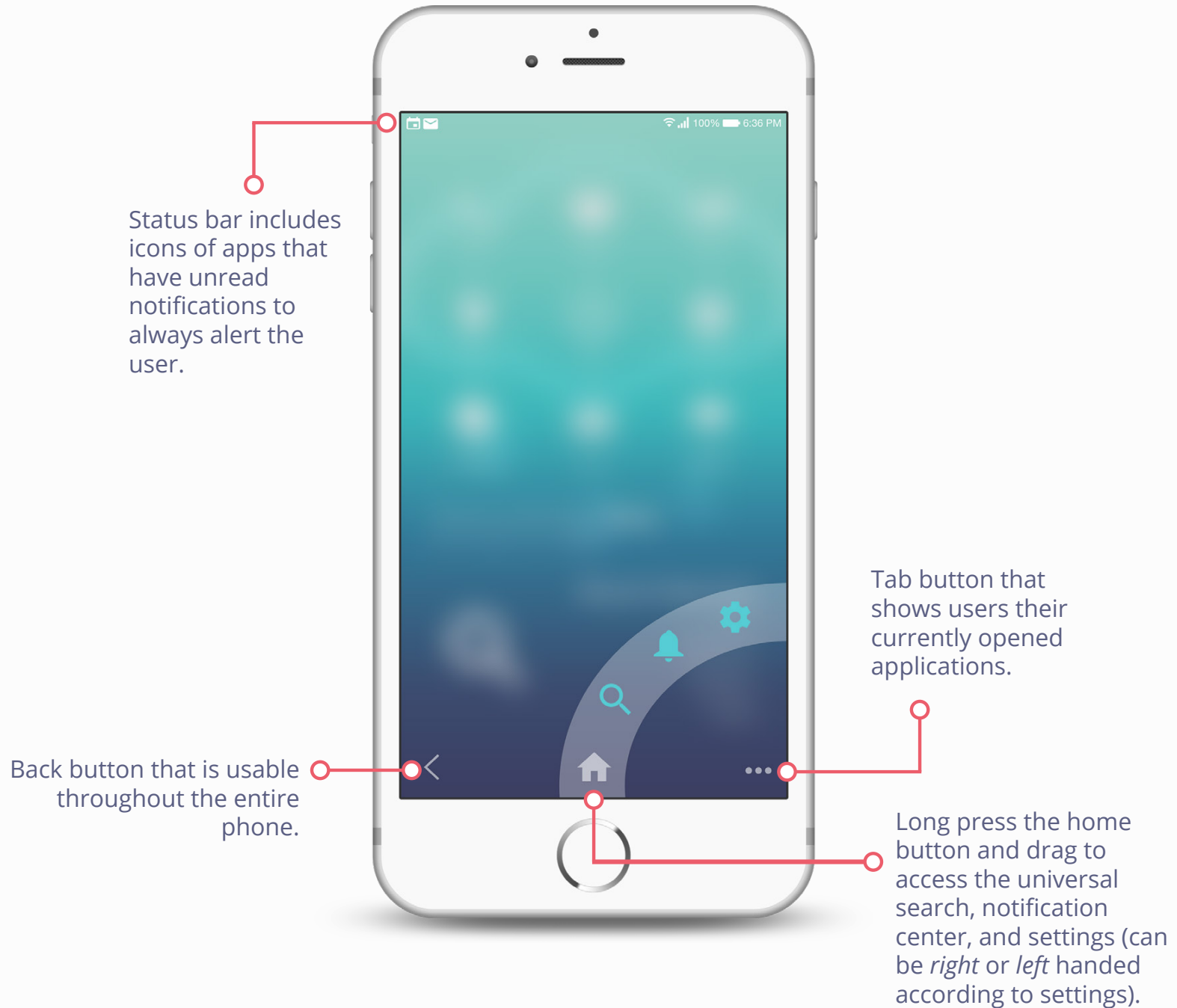
The day of the week is provided above the time so that opening the calendar isn't required.



This icon changes both on the time of day and the weather currently based on the user's location.

Swipe right to open the camera or use finger print recognition to unlock the phone.

# Home Screen



Shows the top 9 most used applications for quick and easy access.

Users can search their entire phone or just their calendar.

# Weather App

View collapsed version of all weather locations saved.

Brings up the user's events for the day so they know what the weather will be like during those times.

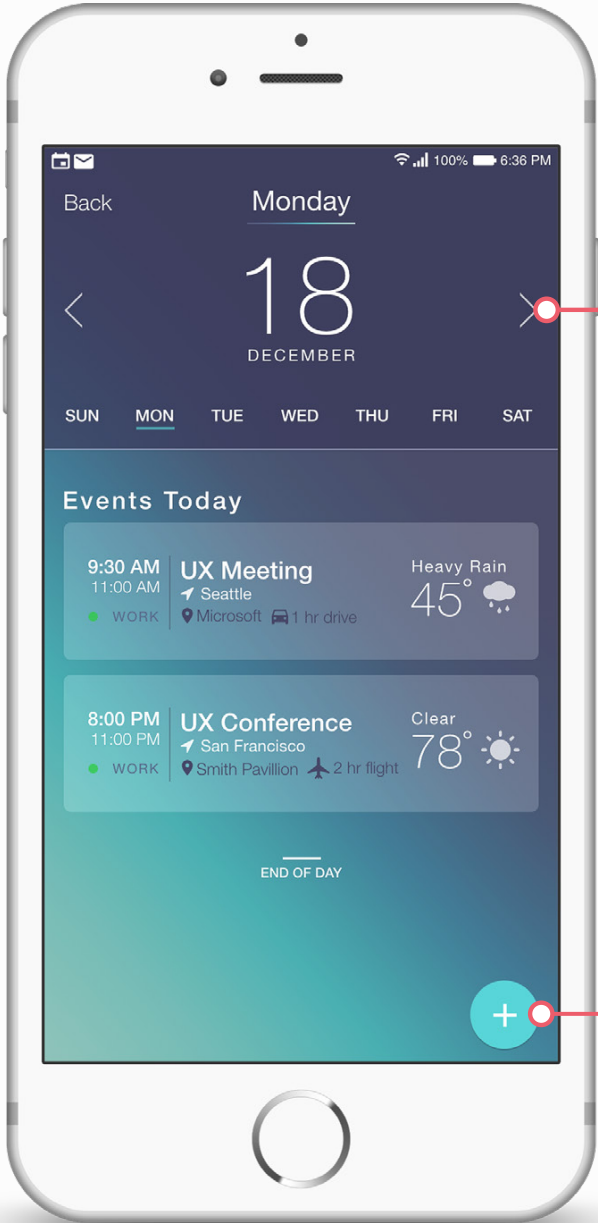
Swipe through the day's projections to discover both the temperature and weather conditions at that time.

# Weather App



Sorted by current location and other locations that are of interest.



Swipe through to see the predicted weather for the entire next week's scheduled calendar events.

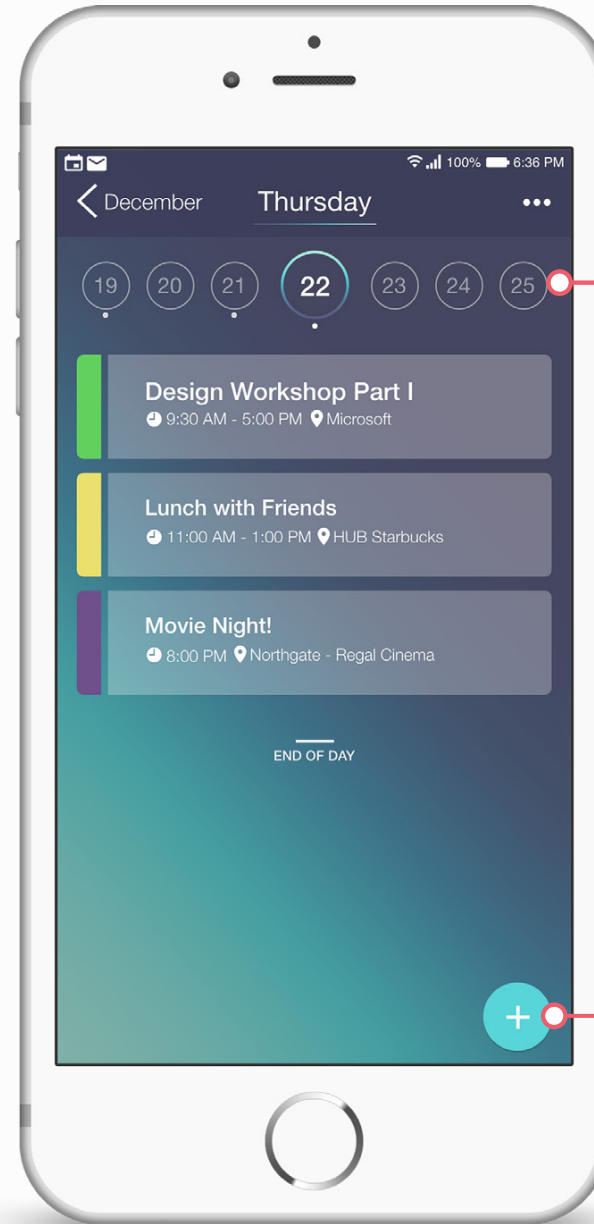
Add new events to the calendar.

View a more detailed look of the events for the current day.

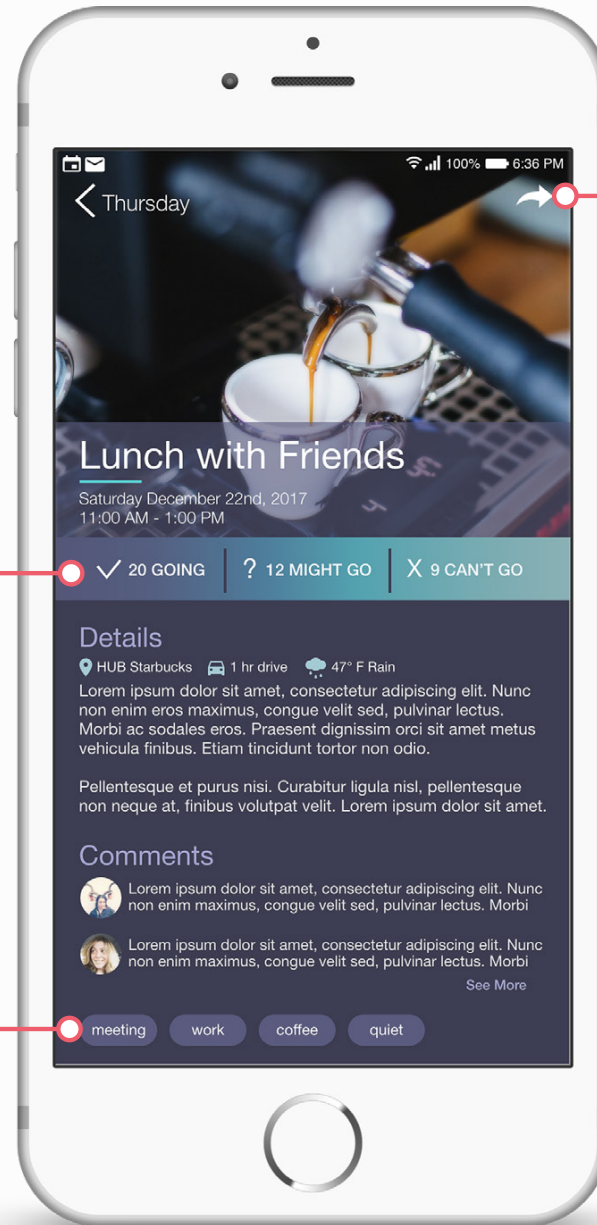


Swipe through to see the entire week's scheduled calendar events.

Share the event with other people who may also be interested in the event.

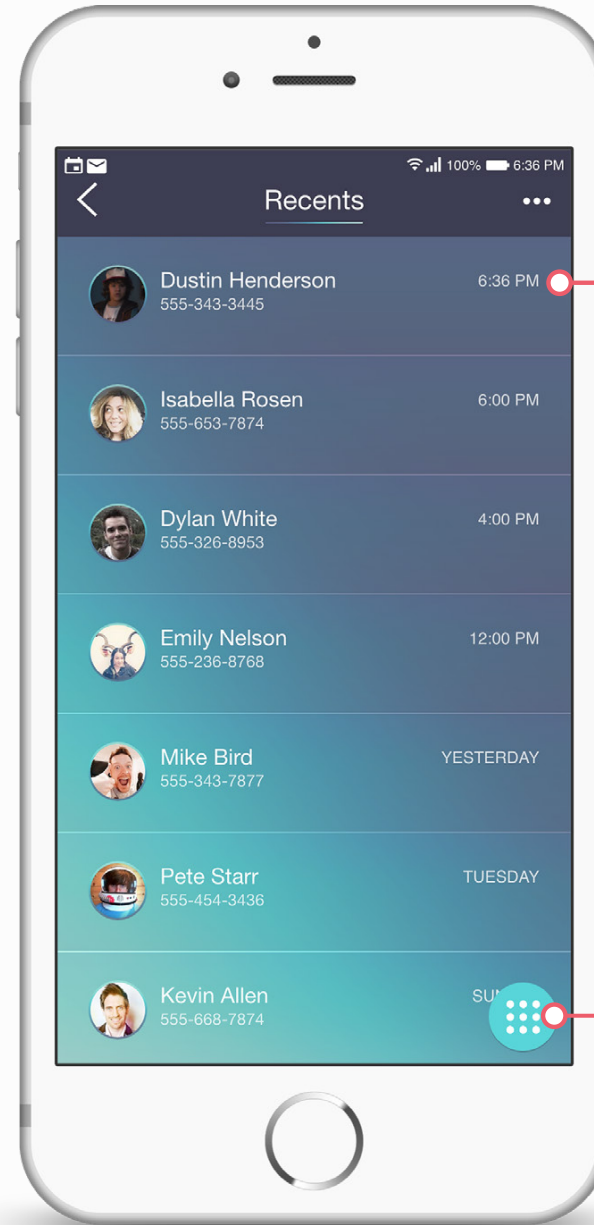
Discover who's interested in an event and who can't go.

# Dialer App



Start a new voice or video call from the same dialer menu.

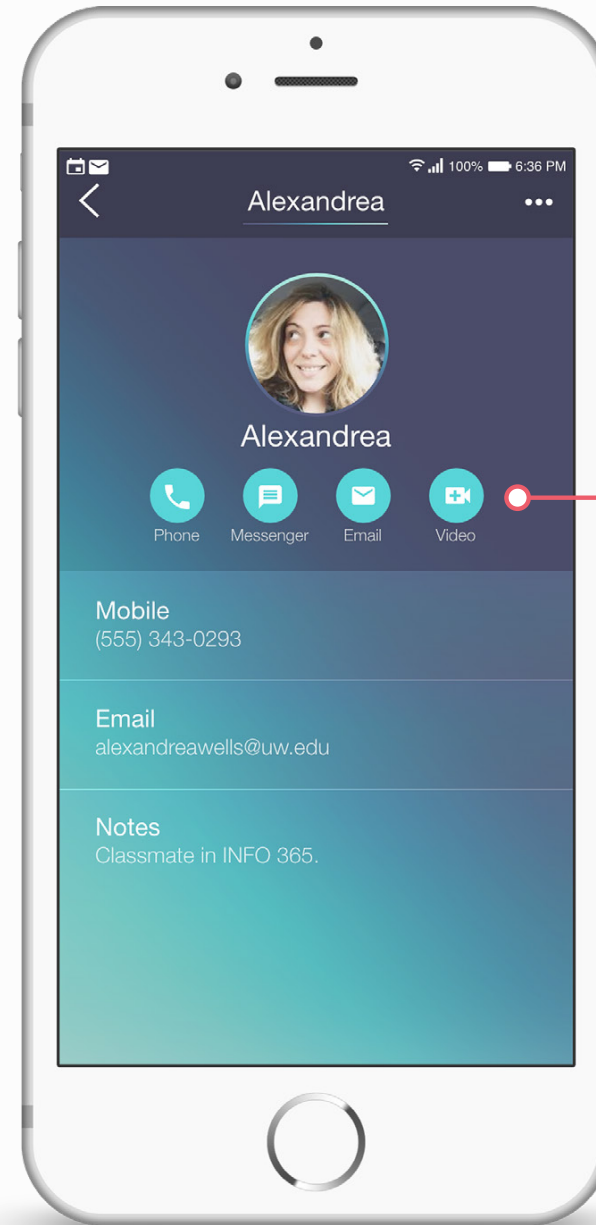
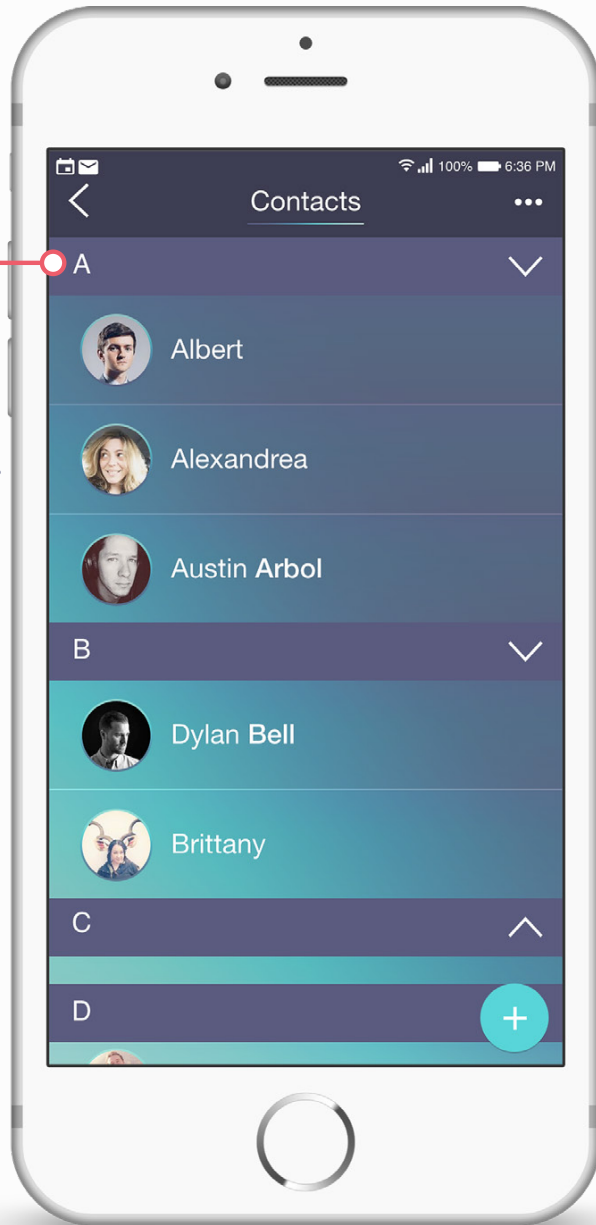


Click on any recent call to contact that person again.

# Contacts App

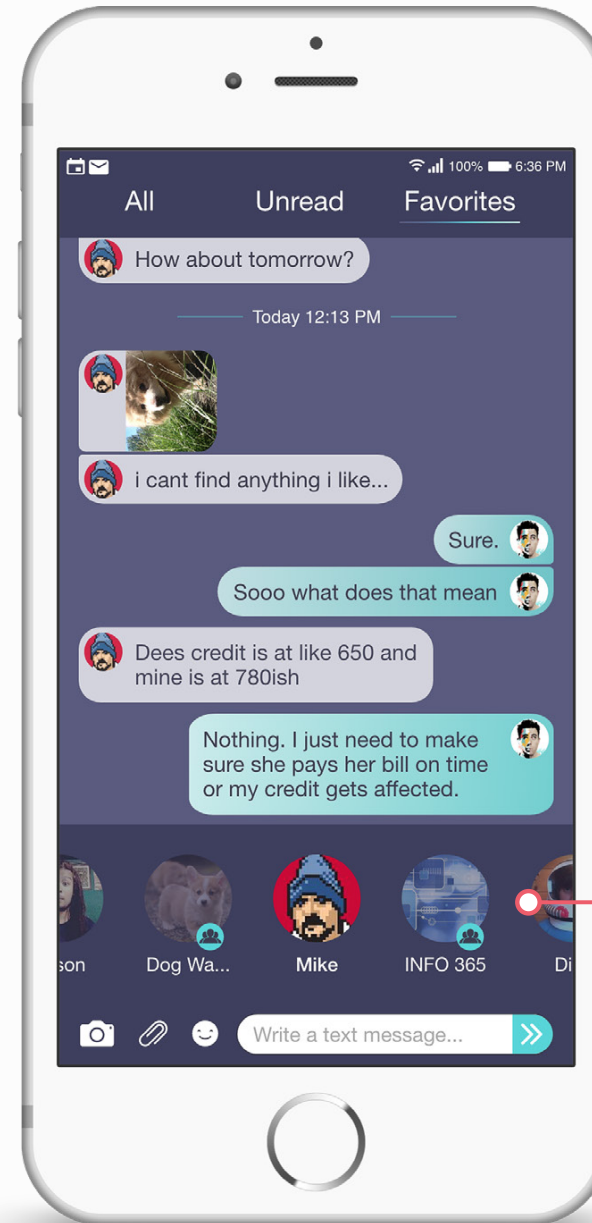
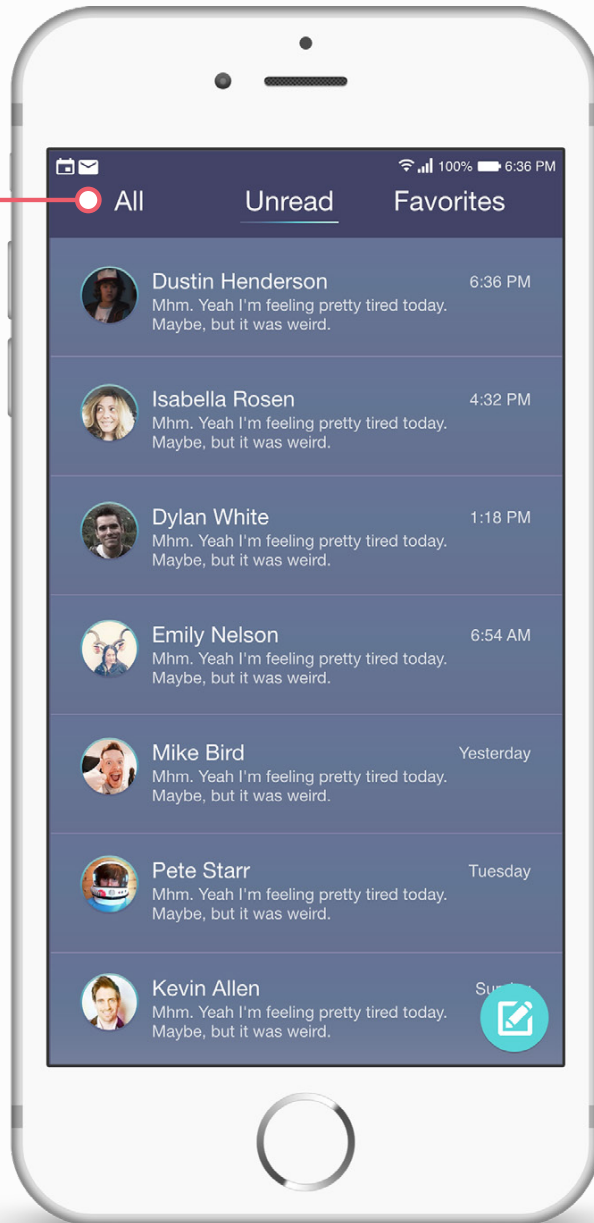
Contacts are sorted alphabetically.



These buttons immediately connect the user to a contact without having to know their actual information.

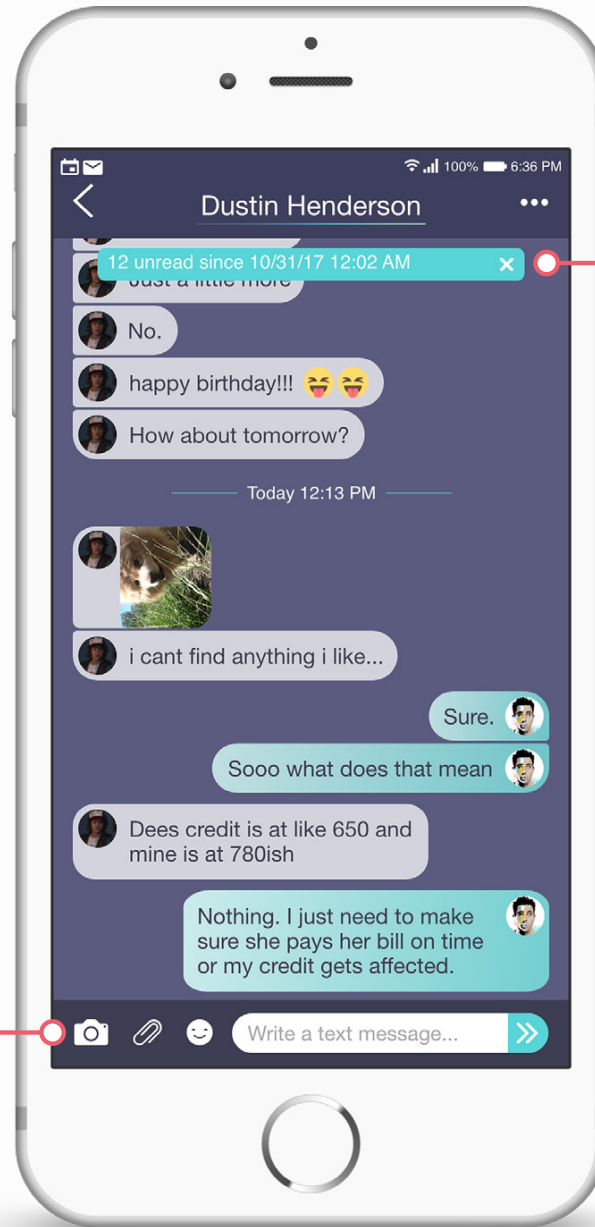
# Messenger App

Swipe through favorited messages to discover new messages more quickly.

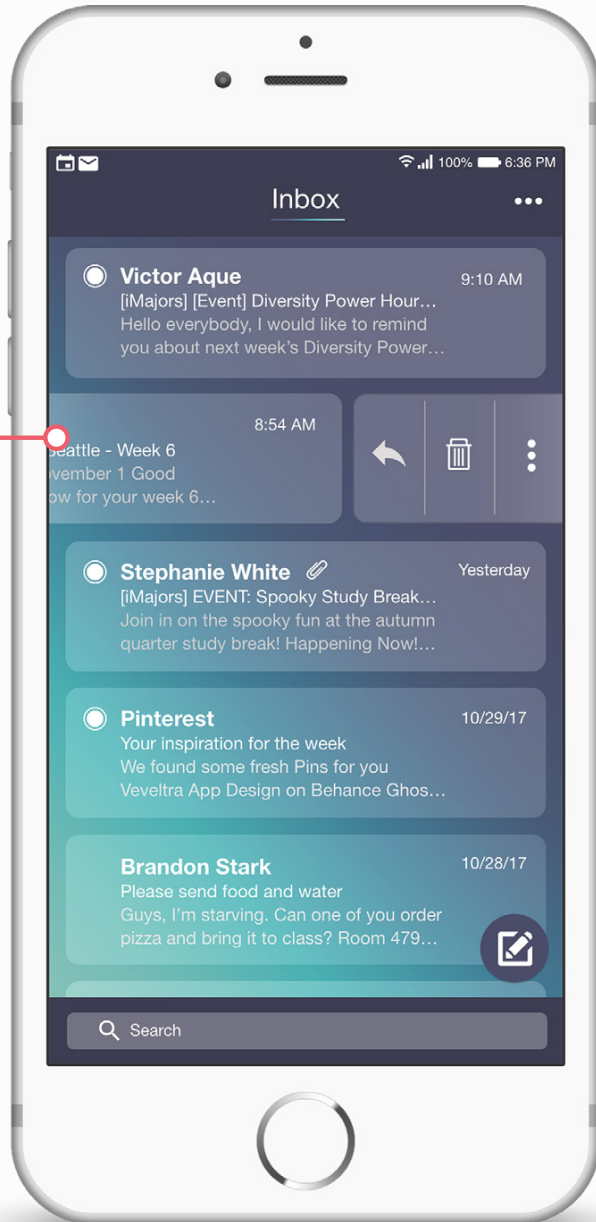
# Messenger App



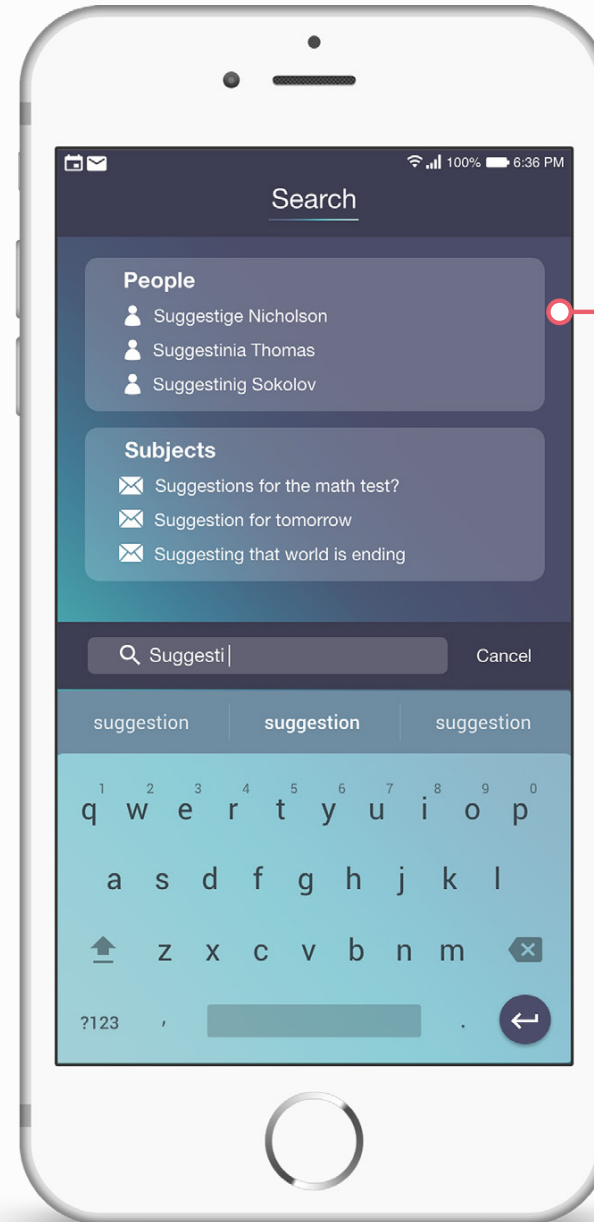
Stay up to date on how many messages have been missed since the last visit.

Swipe left to reveal quick commands for sharing, deleting, or more settings.

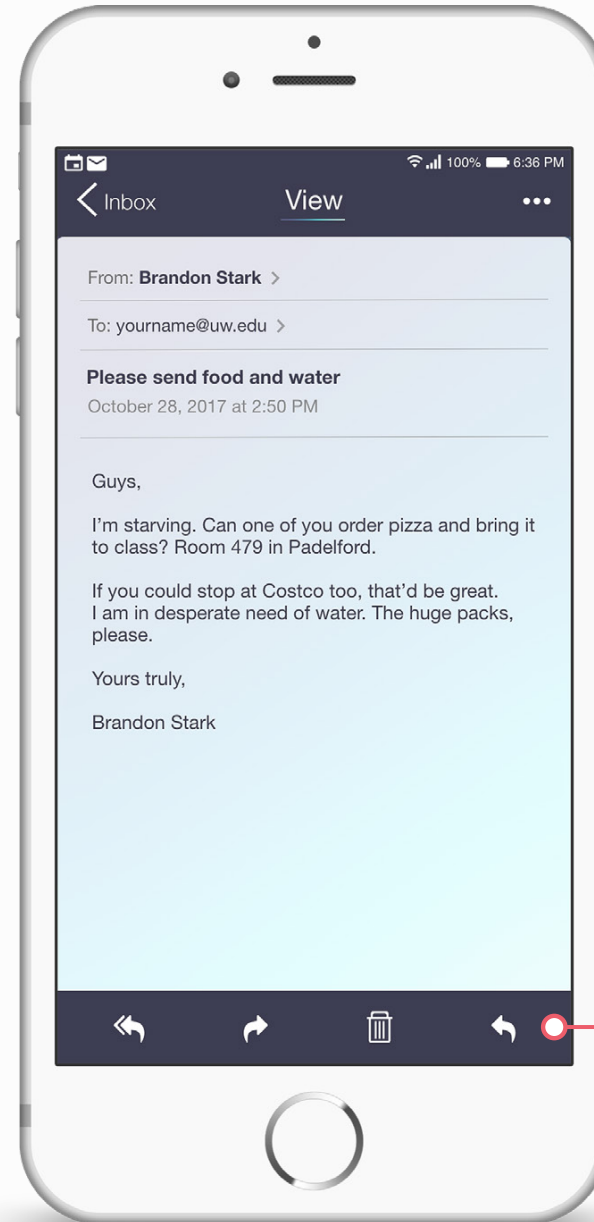


Email search results are separated into people and emails to find particular results more quickly.

# Email App

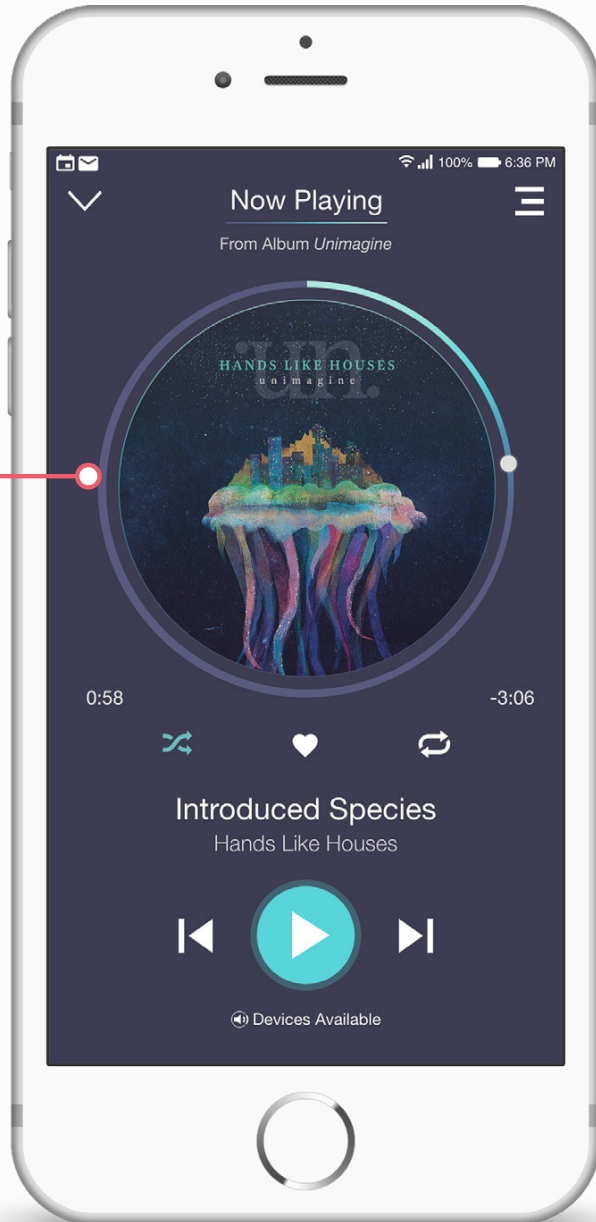


Names can be used in place of emails if an email has been listed under that particular contact.

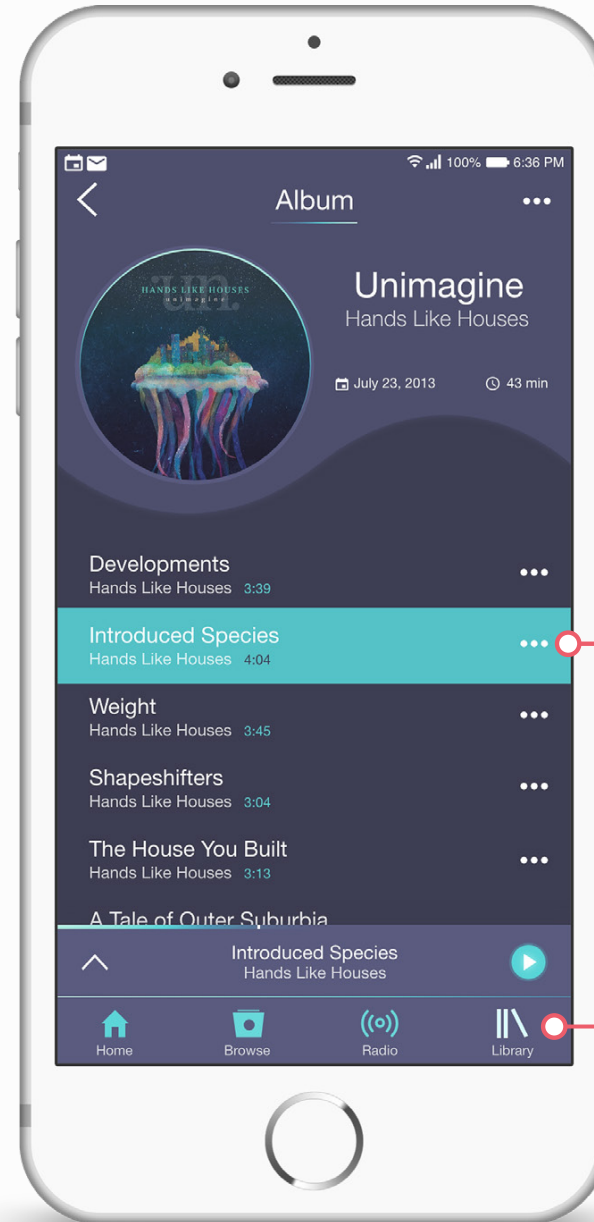


Convenient email commands are placed along the bottom for easy access.

# Music Player App



The progress bar for the current song surrounds the album art and can be used to reverse the song manually.



Currently playing song is highlighted in blue.

Play from the phone's library, online library, or radio.



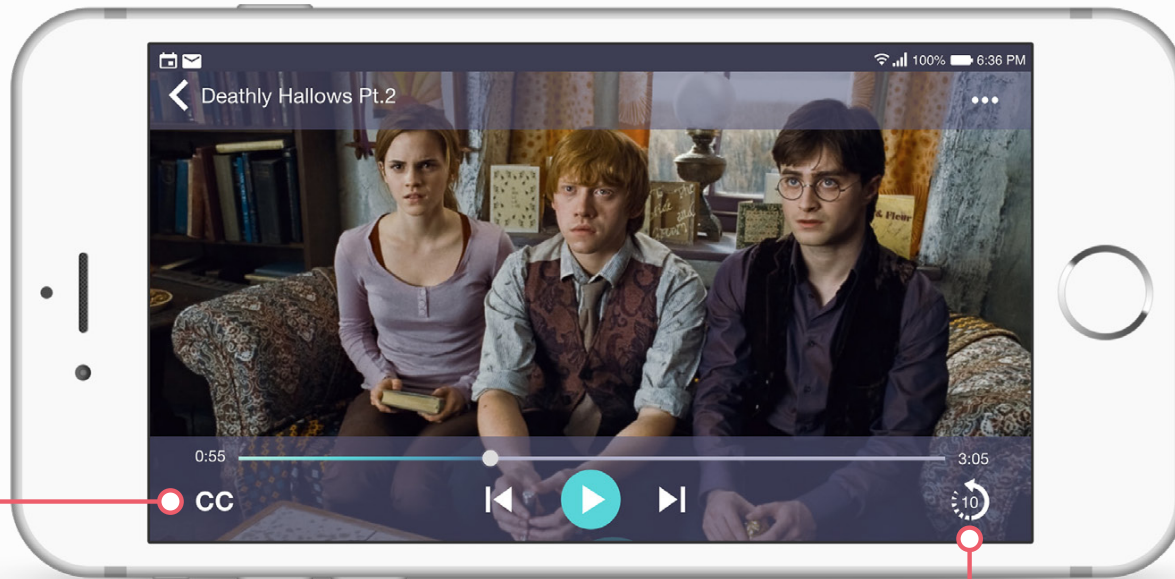
# Video Player App



The user's library is sorted so that titles can be found more easily.

The store, like the online provided shows/movies, gives suggestions for shows likely to be of interest.

# Video Player App



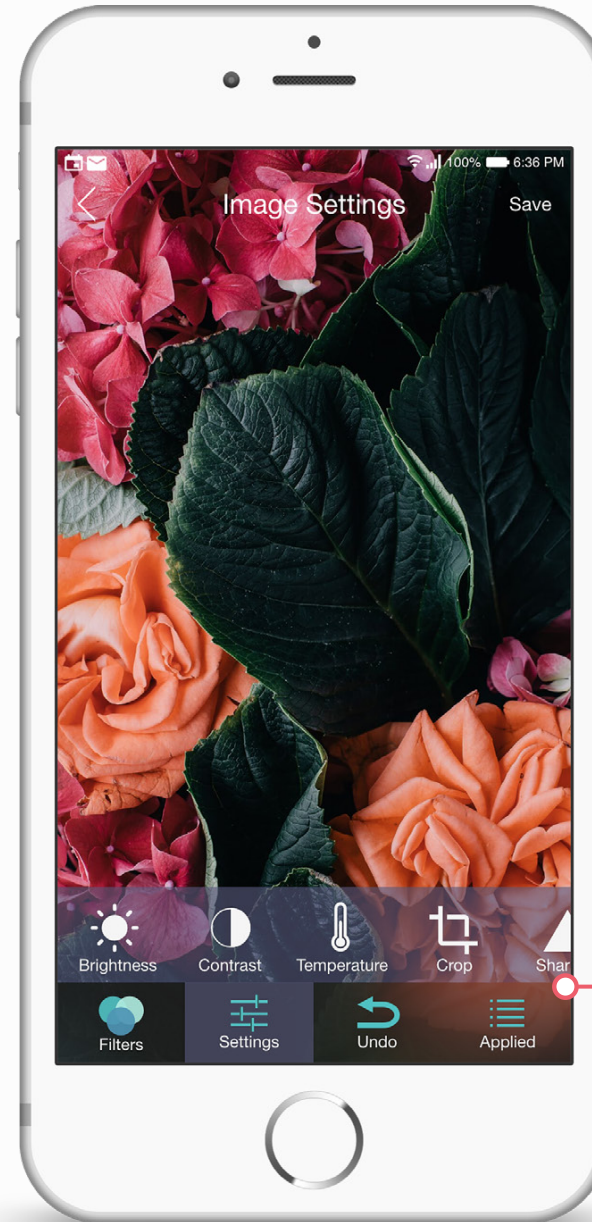
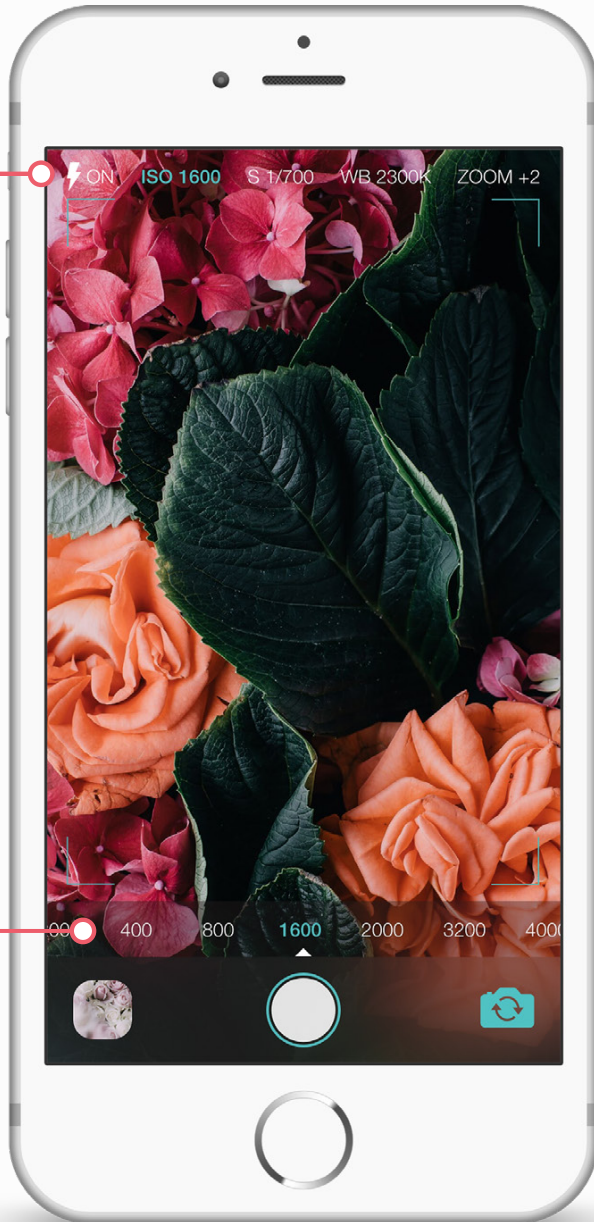
Add captions easily if viewing conditions make it hard to hear.

# Camera App

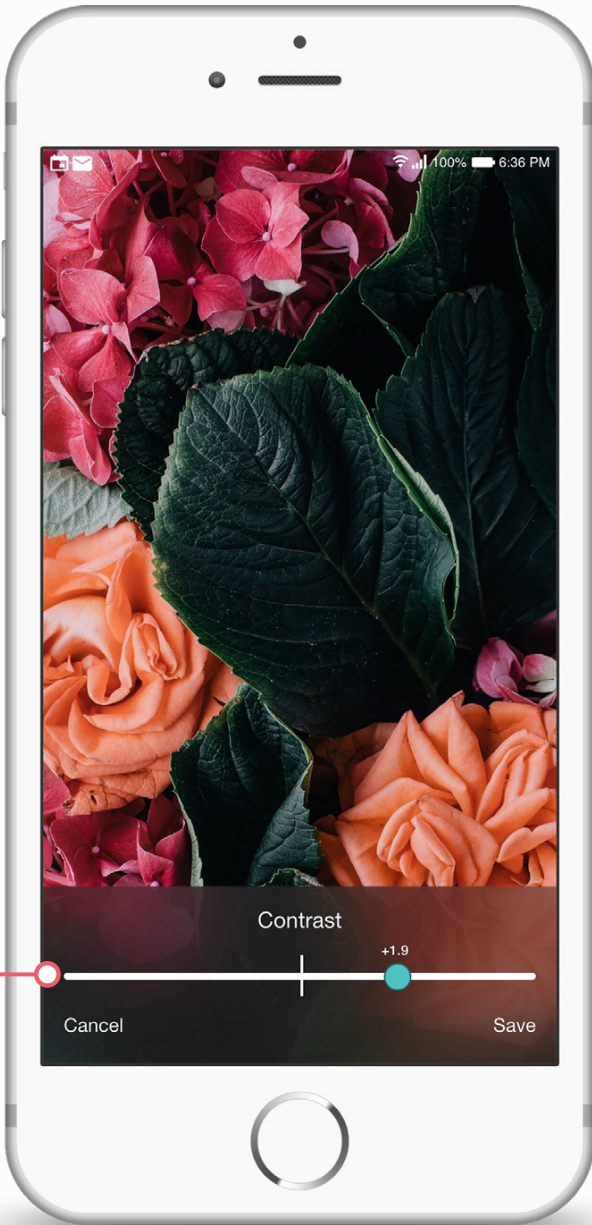
Tap to pick the camera settings that are changed.

Swipe through recommended settings.

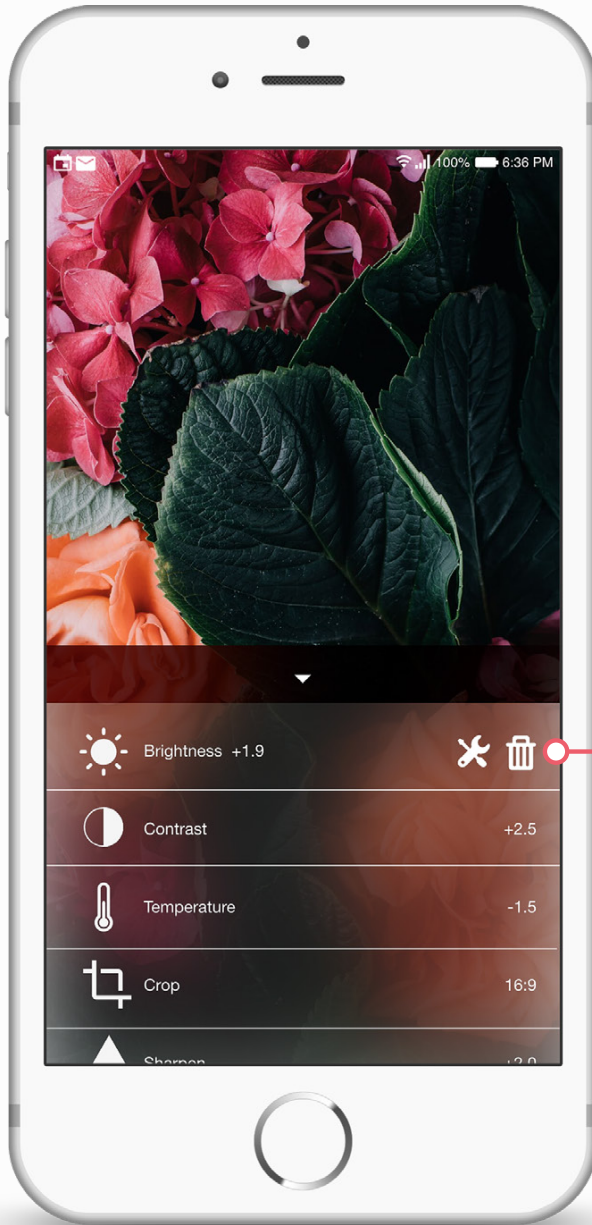


Add filters or change other editing settings all from the same location.

# Camera App

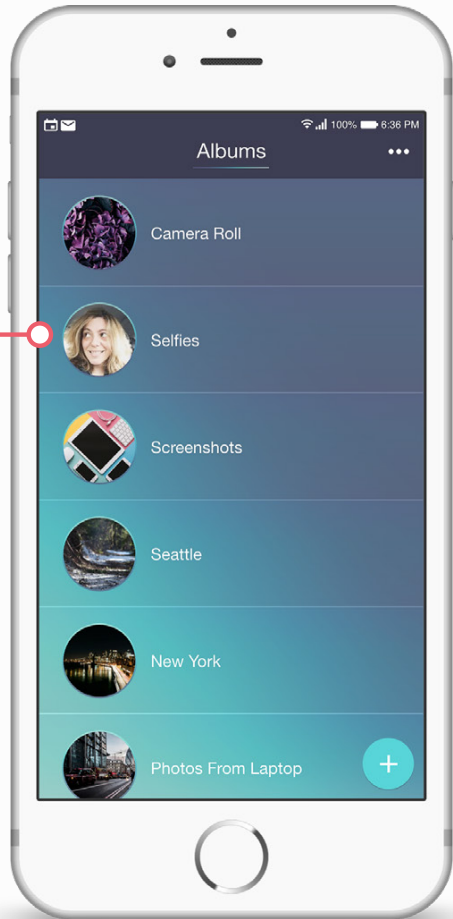


Swipe left or right to decrease or increase the chosen setting.

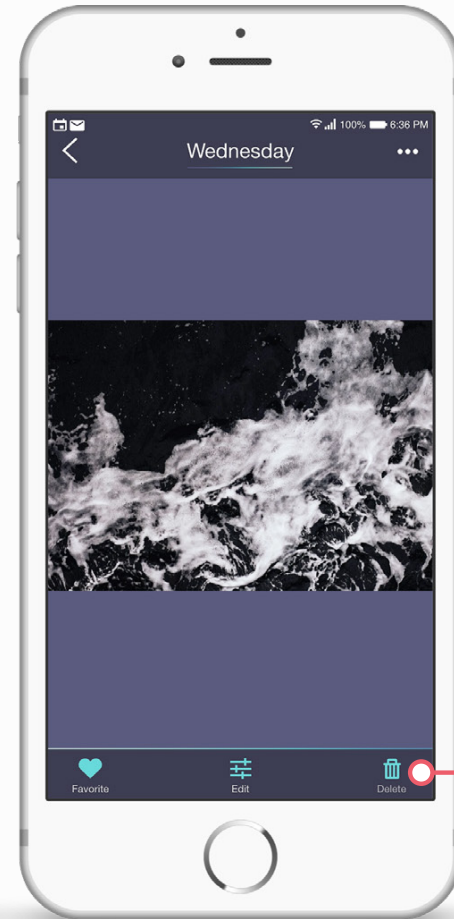
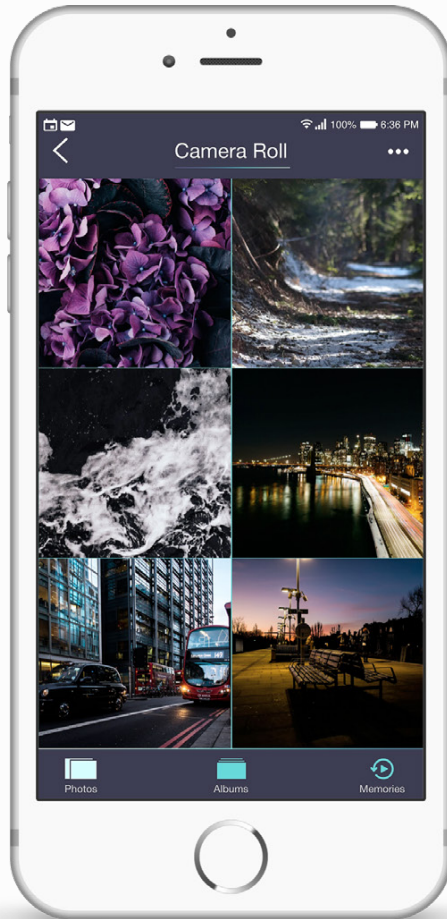


Swipe left to either edit or delete the applied setting.

# Gallery App



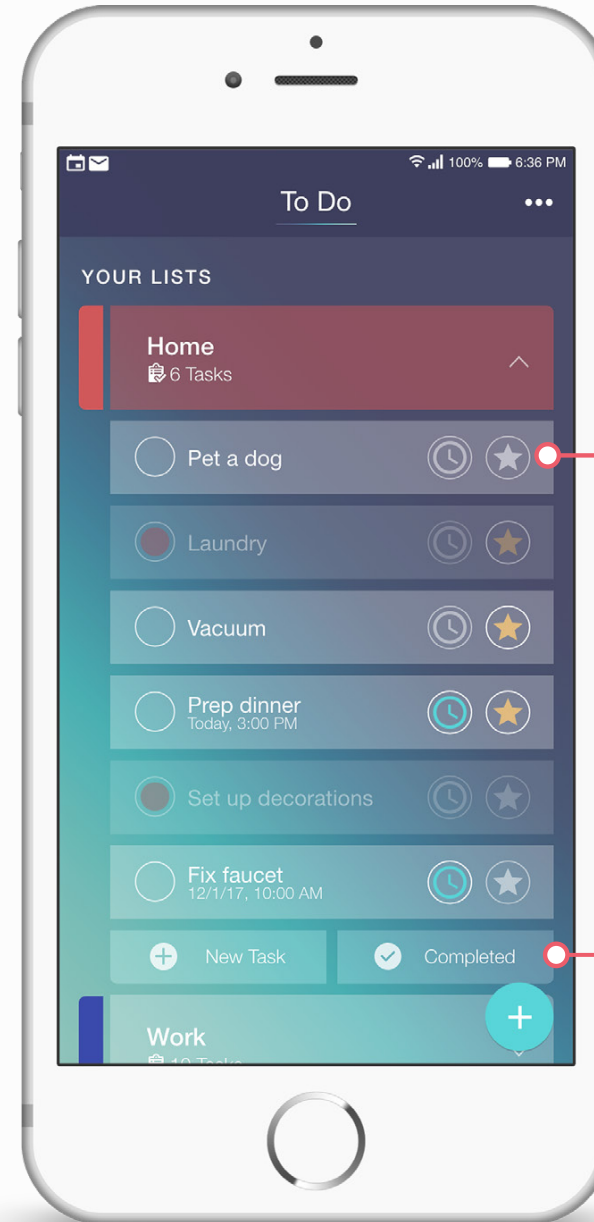
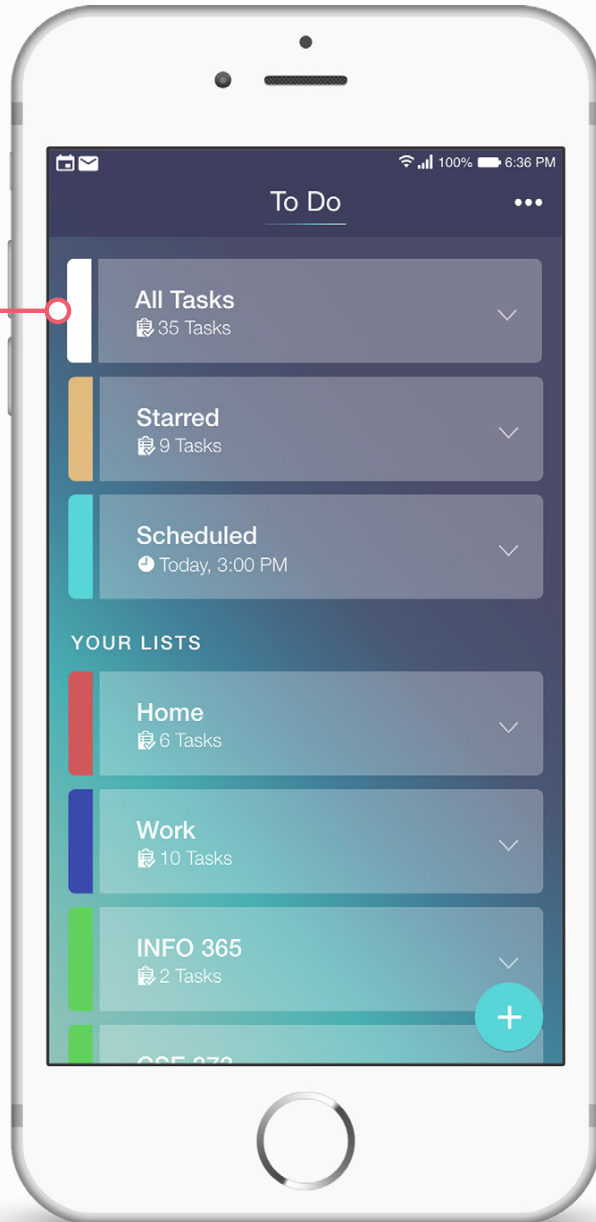
Organize photos into albums to make it easier to share and discover photos.

# To Do List App

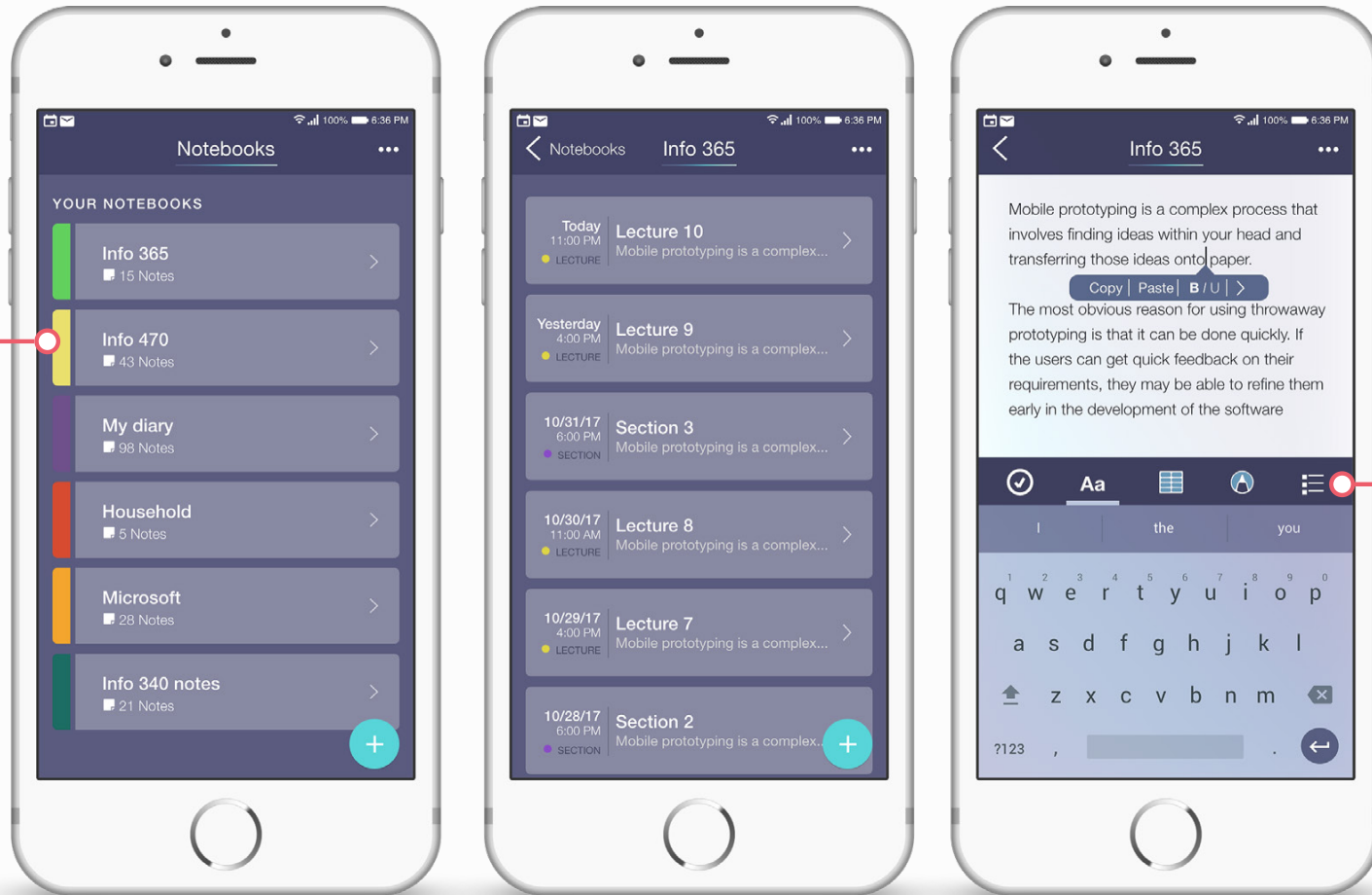
Label different lists with colors to make them easy to recognize.



Add a deadline to a task or favorite tasks that require special attention.

Add a new task to the current list or view completed tasks.

# Notes App

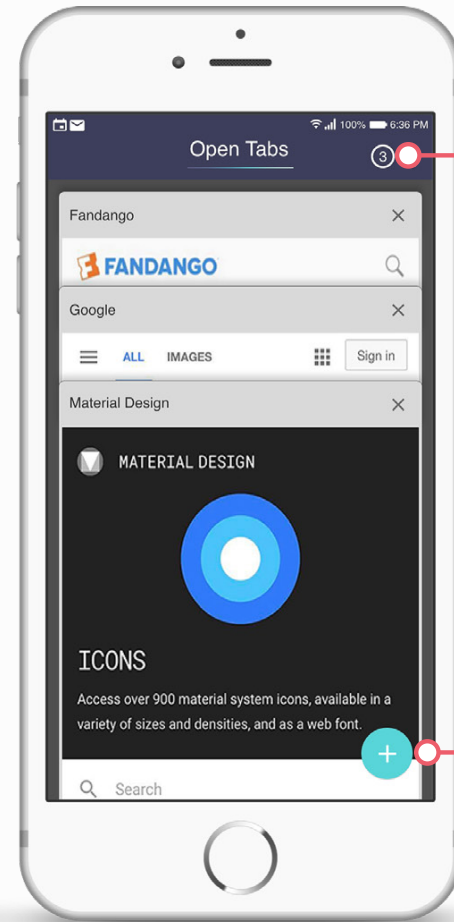
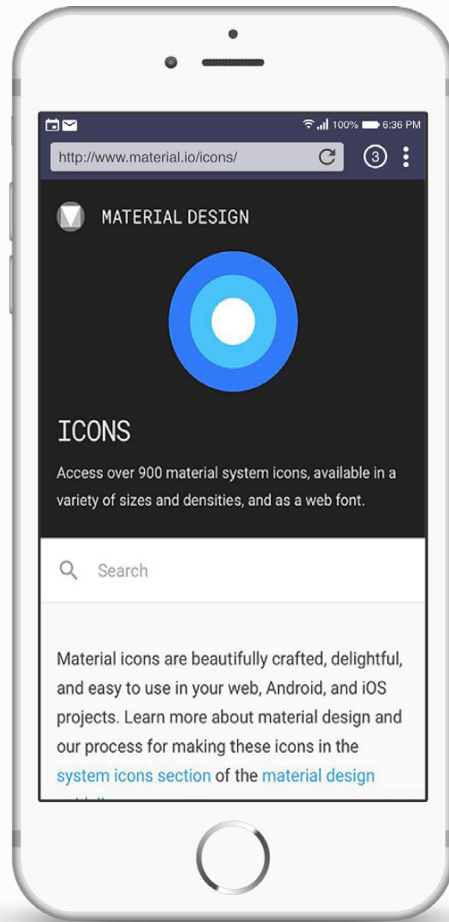
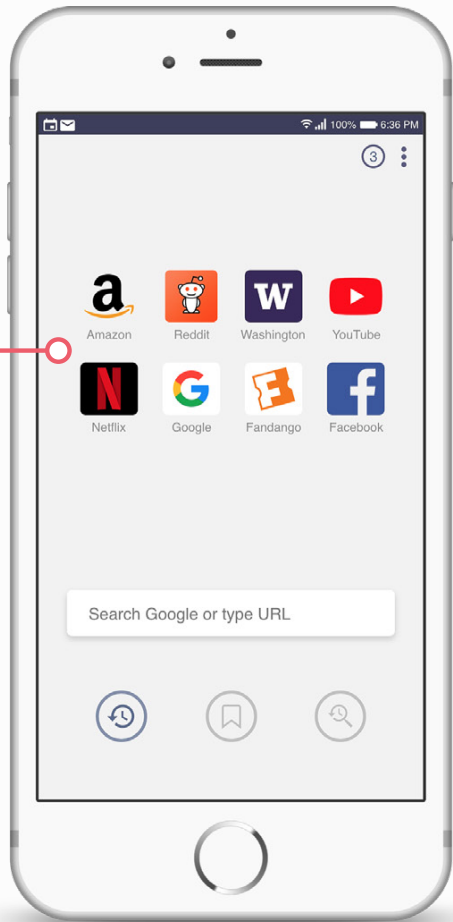


Label each notebook with a color to make it easy to distinguish between individual entries.

These tools make it easy to customize text with tables, highlighting, or lists.

# Browser App

Records the 8 most visited websites for easy access later.



Always records the number of tabs open.

Opens a new browser tab.



# Calculator App



Shows the last calculation entered and its result.



Most recent calculation shown first.

Keep swiping to reveal more calculations.

# Clock App



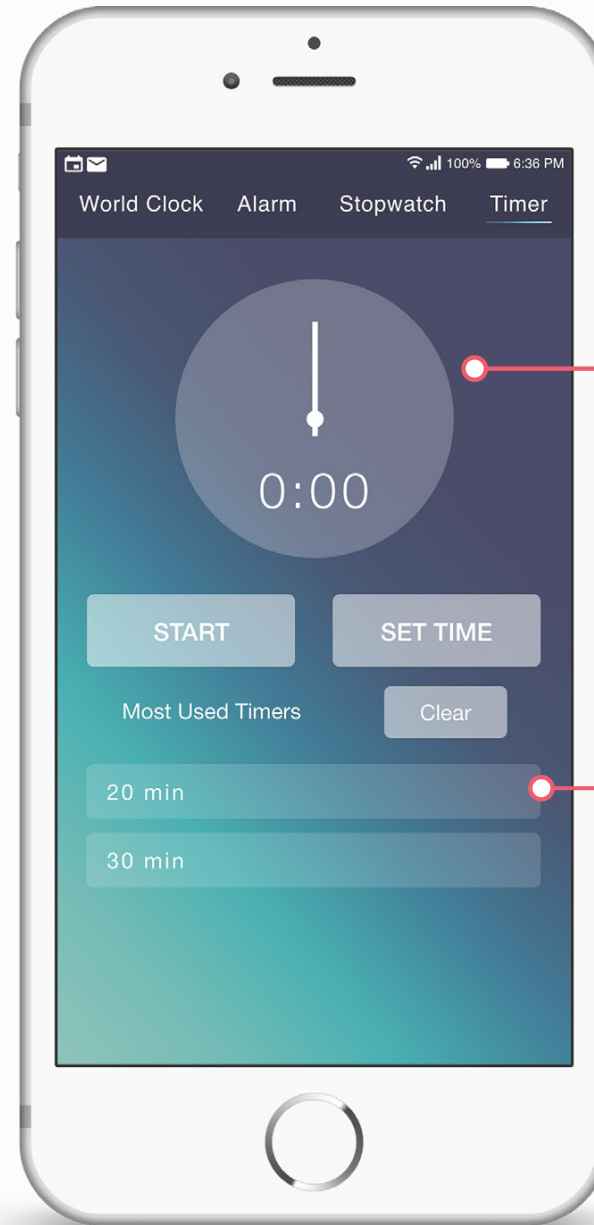
A swipe must be used to dismiss an alarm to ensure that it's not turned off by accident.

Add additional world clocks to keep up to date on their time and weather.

# Clock App



The stopwatch calculates the runner's fastest and slowest lap for personal monitoring.



Records the number of minutes that have passed since the press of the start button.

The most frequently used timers are saved for convenient access later.
